"A Diary of Healing" Exhibit comes to Yale

New Haven, Conn. – "A Diary of Healing" will be on exhibit from February 1-14 at The Thomas E. Golden, Jr. Center at Saint Thomas More, The Catholic Chapel at Yale University, 258 Park Street, New Haven, CT. The Opening Reception featuring Mary Ann Wasil Nilan and photojournalist Christopher Capozziello will take place on Sunday, February 7th at 11am.

The 48-picture exhibition chronicles Mary Ann Wasil Nilan's personal breast cancer journey from home to hospital, through chemotherapy, bi-lateral mastectomy, and reconstruction.

Photojournalist Christopher Capozziello spent two years shadowing Mary Ann, who was frustrated with the lack of literature that could help her deal with the physical and emotional realities of breast cancer. His photographs of her have been described as *"honest, unflinching, and intimately poetic, communicating the stark reality of a life-threatening illness."*

Mary Ann Wasil Nilan is the Executive Director & Founder of the Milford, CT based non-profit organization, The Get In Touch Foundation. Their cornerstone mission is the Get In Touch Girls' Program & Daisy Wheel, teaching girls in grades 5-12 the importance of, and how to do a breast self exam – *for life*.
